Sub: - Declaration of BVO of the concerned block as authorized representative of State Animal Welfare Board for inspection of Dog breeding & Marketing establishments /pet shops

Ref: F & ARD notification no.7875/FARD Dt 17.07.2020,7884/FARD dt. 17.07.2020.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am to say that, Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Dog Breeding & Marketing) Rules, 2017 and (Pet Shop) Rules, 2018 have been implemented in the state of Odisha with immediate effect from 17.07.2020 vide Notification No. 7875/FARD, Dt. 17.07.2020 and 7884/ FARD dt 17.07.2020 respectively. As per the above said Rules, the Dog Breeding and Marketing establishments and Pet Shop units will submit applications for registration through concerned CDVOs.

As per the above mentioned Rules, the State Animal Welfare Board (SAWB), Odisha shall, on receipt of an application for registration, cause the establishment of the breeder/pet shop to be inspected by a team comprising of an authorized representative of the State Animal Welfare Board, Odisha and a veterinary practitioner.

Accordingly, the Block Veterinary officer of the concerned block will act as the authorized representative of SAWB, Odisha and the veterinary practitioner will be the VAS/AVAS of the concerned/adjacent block for the purpose of inspection.
